On Tuesday, May 8, the Palo Alto School Board approved the Addison School Modernization Project. We want to alert you that construction will start soon.

The project design started in 2015 when a generous anonymous donor offered to support facilities upgrades at the school. A planning team of staff, parents and community members held a series of community meetings to get input on needs, resulting in a design that will include seven new classrooms, a new library, a larger multi-purpose room and a modern administrative building.

Our purpose is **not** to increase the enrollment but to provide enhanced learning opportunities for the current number of students.

School ends on June 1, and construction will start on June 4, with the demolition and removal of the old multipurpose room while students are on summer break. We anticipate the work will take 27 months and conclude in August 2020.

We realize this project will impact traffic and parking and we will continue to work diligently with the contractor, the City and other affected parties to minimize the disruption to the community, ensure student safety and continue our excellent educational programs.
